The project **Empowering Local Youth through Self-employment Program: Bamboo House Building Project (BHBP) -2008** will be executed by Nepal Development Initiative with the financial support of Nepal Development Marketplace under an initiative 'Launa Aba ta Kehi Garu' in a local partnership of SELF Nepal. The project main objective is to develop self employment of local youths by enhancing their capacity on building bamboo houses. Under a completion of project in total 13 affordable, luxuries, cheaper, and anti earthquake houses will be build up including a model house in a public place. Due to it's positive impact other 15 houses will be build up during one year period in a local initiatives. The project envisions to eliminate the tradition of wasting huge and unaffordable money on house construction. As a result, the economic condition of people will be increased as well local resource will be highly consumed. The direct beneficiaries of the project will be the local youths representing dalit, ethnic, indigenous, marginalized and vulnerable communities. In one side, the dense forest of bamboo will be utilized and in the other the economic burden of community people for making house will be reduced.

By the completion of project, 15 youths will be trained and self employed in building bamboo house. A new initiation will be inaugurated from Ilam district, which will be applicable in marginalized communities such as Kamiyas, landless, homeless, disaster victims and IDPs. The project is eco friendly and sustainable as well as community based.

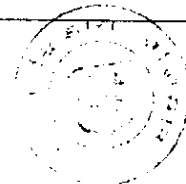
Project Question 1

What is the problem(s)/issue(s) your project is addressing? What are the causes of the problem? (maximum 500 words)

Thousands people are living without houses. The landless, homeless, ploughmen, kamaiyas, dalit and economically vulnerable communities are depriving from making houses and obliged to reside in street, public places and other's houses. More than that, Tarai people are reside underground by making bunker in the land. The deteriorated economic status and traditional norms and values are the major reasons behind this. Similarly, maximum youths from local communities are migrating to cities for employment opportunities. Only the parents and elder persons are residing in village areas. Thus they do not pay their attention on making houses.

Numbers of families in Ilam district are living without comfortable house. Because of the deteriorated economic condition the dalit, ethnic and other secluded communities' people are still deprived from shelters. They are not able to build safe and comfortable houses. In context of project target areas, mostly in ethnic and dalit communities' people are obliged to stay in miserable condition houses due to the lack of economy. The day to day affair of hand to mouth became great burden for them. They work for the day and the wages is used for morning and evening time feeding. Normally, the women are engaged in domestic works and men work in other's land. There are not other alternatives to be followed beside continuing the tradition. Because of that, they are not able to pay attention on making houses. By reaching those communities directly, the project will address following problems;

Project Question 2

How does your idea address the problem(s)/issue(s) described above in terms of securing peace through development, delivery of basic services and expanding livelihood opportunities to rural population? (maximum 500 words).

Due to the increasing employment crisis, numbers of problems and challenges are emerging in society. Numbers of youths are migrating to city areas and foreign land for different perilous works. They are involving in different criminal activities, murdering, looting, terrorizing and indulging themselves on different addictions. On the one hand, youths are roaming in unemployment and migration and on the other the community people are encountering with numbers of traditions, discrimination and scarcity. The traditional thinking and discrimination will be reduced by political awareness but the challenge of poverty, unemployment and scarcity will not decrease without enriching their economic condition. Without creating employment opportunities, developing entrepreneurship and engaging them on different income generating programs, the challenges remain as it is. Their engagement in illegal activities and migration exist for long run. The political stability became the matter of far distance as it directly correlates with the appropriate settlement of social problems. It means in society there is high demand of employment based and income generating activities.

By involving the local unemployed youths in the project and empowering them with the capacity of bamboo house construction, the self-employment opportunities will be created and the employment opportunities directly support on enriching their economic status. Similarly, the basic need of shelter will be solved through, cheap, affordable, available and comfortable bamboo houses. The involvement of local people and mobilization of local resources will develop ownership as well as reduce the high expenses of making houses in other models. The trend of migration will be reduced and youth's engagement in abnormal activities will be decreased. By being economically strong, the society directs towards peace, stability and development. Thus the project supports in peace process and also helps in poverty alleviation.

Project Question 3

How will you implement your idea? Describe in detail each of the activities/steps that your project will undertake to meet its objective(s). (maximum 600 words). Please provide a corresponding timeline in a separate sheet.

Brief glimpse of activities outlining :

1. Agreement with donor agency: After the final selection of project an agreement will be done in between NEDI and donor agency. The agreement covers detail activities, time line and other technical part of the project.

2. Strategy formation for better implementation: A 3 member project steering committee (PSC) will be formed after the project approved. The committee will handle overall activities of project.

3. Meeting with partner organization: To finalize the work plan and time line a meeting will be organized in between partner organization SELF Nepal and NEDI.

4. Meeting and discussion with stakeholders: As the project will be executed in Barbote and Sumbek VDCs of Ilam a discussion and sharing meeting will be held in between the secretaries of VDCs, representatives of organizations and local level political parties leaders.

5. Selection of field supervisor:

A field supervisor will be selected for the project through the discussion between partner organization and PSC. Priority will give to women, representing dalit and disadvantage communities.

6. Establishment of contact office

A contact office will be established in Barbote VDC by making discussion with partner organization.

7. Selection of beneficiary community and youth for training

The PSC by making discussion with partner organization, VDC secretaries, local level political parties leaders and other stakeholders will select the beneficiaries communities and trainees for bamboo house construction training. The selection of beneficiaries will be almost from dalit, ethnic and indigenous, marginalized and disadvantage people.

8. Training on bamboo house construction:

15 days training on modern bamboo house construction will be organized in the partner organization training hall. For the thematic and practical part of the training a resource person will be hired from industries working in bamboo house construction. A sample house will be built up during training period.

9. Sample house exhibition, inauguration and public hearing program

An exhibition and inauguration program will be inaugurated by the women representing dalit community after completion. The GOs, I/NGOs, ethnic and indigenous groups, dalit communities and other recognized organization will be the participants. A public hearing program will be organized to disseminate the information, importance and cost of bamboo house construction.

10. House construction program

A house construction program will be launched in Barbote and Sumbek VDC targeting homeless and landless people representing dalit and disadvantage communities. The identified beneficiaries will be supported by implementing organization where community contribution is highly valued. For each house a maintenance fund will be established. At least 30% contribution of total expenditure is must.

11. Coordination and collaboration

A discussion meeting cum workshop will be organized every month to share about the progress, challenges and future strategies in between partner organization, local level organization representatives, VDC representatives and other stakeholders.

12. Monitoring and evaluation

The project will be regularly monitored by field supervisor, partner organization's representatives and project team. The evaluation will be accomplished on the concluding phase by a committee representing user group, VDC representatives and funding agencies.

13. Public auditing

After the completion of project a public auditing will be accomplished with the participation of local community

People, project team, trainees, local level organization representatives, political leaders, government office representatives, journalists and civil society representatives.

14. Reporting

Tri monthly report will be submitted to funding agency including major progresses, challenges and lessons learnt. For preparing report a standard form will be used. After the completion of project, a final progress report will be submitted by mentioning progresses, case studies, photos, news clips and recommendations for future directions. The report will be in both electronic and print form.

Project Question 4

How is your idea innovative or different from existing approaches that are addressing the problem(s)/issue(s) you have described in question one? Why did you choose this particular approach? The project supports on procuring self-employment to youths by developing skill and capacity on bamboo house construction. The basic need of shelter will be fulfilled by using local resource in minimum cost. The dalit, landless, ethnic and indigenous communities peoples, who are not able to build houses due to their deteriorated economic status are the direct beneficiaries. Not a single organization GOs or I/NGO take an initiative to seek an alternative in house construction. The capable people are wasting high amount in making house and the poor are not able to build good house. The accessible local resource is not utilized and nobody pay attention in this regard.

As the numbers of families are being homeless and numbers of youth are unemployed, the project directly addresses this problem. By mobilizing the local resources and making participation of unemployed youths employment opportunities will be created and an initiation of making bamboo house will began. The bottom up approach is the core approach for implementing the project. The selected district for project is naturally beautiful. The district has already sets it's recognition on tourism and agricultural development. But, the marginalized castes, dalit (Kami, Damai, Sarki), ethnic and indigenous locality and other economic vulnerabilities are not able to build houses by roaming on poverty.

Taking this initiative NEDI envisions to uplift the economic status of marginalized and vulnerable communities as well supports on reducing high cost of house construction. Gradually, the trends of making unplanned houses will be eliminated and environment friendly system will be established. Similarly, the project is applicable in Tarai, landless areas and other economically vulnerable areas.

Though, in the beginning phase only 13 bamboo houses will be built up in target areas, it will commence an initiative for the areas where the bamboos are accessible.

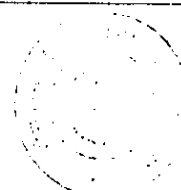

Project Question 8

The first and foremost beneficiaries of the project are the unemployed youths representing dalit, ethnic, minorities and excluded communities. During selection of trainees, priority will be given to the under SL.C youths. In context of project target area, there is the maximum residence of dalit, ethnic and indigenous whose economic condition is almost deteriorated. For making comfortable house for them would be the great burden. In great numbers youths are migrating to city areas and neighboring Indian territories. The remaining youths are roaming in unemployment and indulging themselves on different addictions. As the project is launched to build cheap, affordable and available houses, there would be the almost participation of dalit, marginalized and disadvantage people by prioritizing inclusion and measuring the economic status by PSC. Before commencing house construction, a user group and maintenance fund will be established. The beneficiary house ownership must have to ratify a commitment for contribution, full support and caring the house in long run. To develop an ownership at least 30% contribution will be compulsory which will be included on commitment paper. As the project is based on need basis, participatory, maximum utilization, innovative and affordable technology, the people will highly accept, contribute and cooperate to reach the project objectives.

By it's internal resources of organization a day refreshment and experience sharing workshop will be organized. As the project is itself innovative, new, affordable and available. the community people automatically involved on bamboo house construction and the community people will coordinate with VDC and DDC for allocation of government budget for bamboo house construction.

The partner organization is locally established and working on the same field since a decade. By making coordination with NEDI, the project will be extended to other places of country. The community people will empowered by other skills of bamboo materials by the joint effort of NEDI and SELF Nepal.

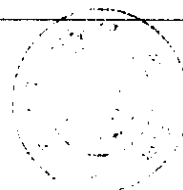
